

Travel to the Representation of the State of North-Rhine Westphalia to the European Union



Travelling by train and metro – By train you usually travel to the station 'Bruxelles Midi/Brussel Zuid'. At the station, go to the metro (blue sign with a white M) and buy a ticket from the ticket machine. Take line 2 or 6 in the direction of 'Simonis (Elisabeth)' and travel 5 stops to 'Trône/Troon'. Get off there and walk in the direction of 'Montoyer'. Walk down the 'Rue Montoyer' for about 200 metres. On the right-hand side of the street, you will find the Representation of the State of North Rhine-Westphalia at number 47.

Travelling by plane – You arrive at Brussels-Zaventem Airport. Here you have 3 options:

- a) Take a taxi journey time approx. 30 minute;
- b) Take the train (at level 1) to 'Bruxelles-Luxembourg' station. Journey time approx. 18 minutes and 3 stops. Departure approx. every 30 minutes (https://www.brusselsairport.be/en/passengers/access-parking/train). The ticket can be purchased at the ticket counter or from a ticket machine.

Get off at 'Bruxelles-Luxembourg' station and walk in the direction of 'Place du Luxembourg' and then follow 'Rue de Treves' for about 200 metres until you turn left into 'Rue Montoyer'. Follow Rue Montoyer for another 200 metres. On the left-hand side of the street you will then find the Representation of the State of North Rhine-Westphalia at number 47. c) Take bus 12 'Brussels City' (on level 0 (platform C) to the bus stop 'Luxembourg'. Departure approx. every 20 minutes from the hour. Journey time approx. 30 minutes. This applies to weekdays until 8.00 pm. After this time and on weekends and public holidays, please take bus 21 (www.stib-mivb.be). Tickets can be purchased at the GO ticket machines before boarding the bus or when boarding the bus. Get off at 'Place du Luxembourg' and follow 'Rue de Treves' for about 200 metres until you turn left into 'Rue Montoyer'. Follow 'Rue Montoyer' for another 200 metres. On the left-hand side of the street you will find the Representation of the State of North Rhine-Westphalia at number 47.
